2018 Greater Hartford Puerto Rican Day Parade Rules and Regulations

- 1. All participants must submit a completed application and payment by May 1, 2018. Applications and payments will not be accepted after the deadline.
- 2. Only the contact person will be allowed at the registration desk the morning of the parade. Groups will only receive the number of wristbands requested on the application. Wristbands will be made available a week prior to the parade. Registration will begin at 8:30am until 10:30am, at the corner of Wawarme Avenue and Locust Street. The parade will begin promptly at 12:00pm. If your group arrives late, your group will not participate in the parade. No refunds will be provided.
- 3. All vehicles must be in good working condition and must comply with the Motor Vehicle Laws of the State of Connecticut. Cars that are part of a marching unit must be decorated. All drivers must have a valid driver's license. All motorized vehicles including cars, motorcycles, floats will be provided with a vehicle permit/pass that must be displayed at all times during the parade. All vehicles must have at least half a tank of fuel.
- 4. Puerto Rican flags with any other emblem and/or design WILL NOT be permitted in the parade. Any altered Puerto Rican flags will be immediately removed from the parade.
- 5. Music played by participants must be appropriate and in good taste. No profanity will be allowed during the staging or during the parade. The Board of Directors and the parade committee reserve the right to remove participants that violate this rule.
- 6. Participant attire and/or costumes must reflect Puerto Rican culture both appropriately and in good taste. The Board of Directors reserves the right to request a viewing of costumes or attires prior to approving your application. Furthermore, the Board and/or the parade committee reserves the right to remove participants that do not follow this rule.
- 7. Neither elected officials nor participants can engage in political campaigning or distribute political propaganda during the parade or at the festival. This includes political messages. NO Exceptions.
- 8. Participants will not consume and/or distribute alcohol and/or illegal drugs during the staging or throughout the parade.
- 9. Participants will not engage in any activity that may represent a safety hazard to the participants or spectators, ex. revving engines or throwing items into the crowd.
- 10. Violation of any of these rules will constitute grounds for removal from the parade and from future participation as approved by the Board of Directors and/or the Parade committee.
